

Mud, Sweat and Beers 5K F.A.Q.

What do I need at the race?

- Photo I.D.
- Appropriate footwear is highly recommended
- A change of clothes and towel to clean up afterwards
- Spending money for parking, drinks and food

When does the event start?

The Muddy Buddies version (ages 6-12) will start at 10:00am. Please arrive by 9:00am to get checked in!

The young adult (13-20 years old) and the adult (21 years and older) divisions will begin at 1:00pm. Please arrive by 12:00pm in order to get checked in and ready to run!

How much does it cost?

- Muddy Buddies (6-12): \$25 per runner (no t-shirt given)
- Ages 13 and up: \$45 per runner until July 3 / \$55 per runner July 4-10

What to leave at home?

- Outside food and beverage
- Glass containers
- Weapons and/or firearms
- Bad attitudes
- Pets

When and where is Packet Pickup?

Beat the Race Day crowds and come by Sozo Friday, July 9 between 5pm and 7pm to pick up your race packet! Race Day packet pickup will also be available starting at 9:00am. Don't forget your photo I.D. to get your packet!

Can I pick up my friends' packet?

Yes, but you will need the following items:

- Copy of your friend's photo I.D.
- Signed letter from the friend stating you are allowed to pick up their packet
- Signed race waiver from your friend must be submitted prior to packet pickup or you must bring a signed paper copy to pickup their packet.

What do I get as a race participant?

- Race T-shirt (ages 13 and up only)
- Custom finisher medal
- Race Bib with free beverage ticket

Where can I leave my gear?

There will be a free gear check area for all of your gear. Your gear check claim ticket is attached to your race bib.

What if there is inclement weather?

Rain or shine, we will race! Mud, Sweat and Beers 5K reserves the right to cancel or delay the event if runner, spectator or staff safety is compromised. There will be no refunds.

How do I volunteer?
