

Super 5K F.A.Q.

Saturday, May 8, 2021 – Sozo Sports Complex (2200 S. 36th Ave)

This family-friendly 5K encourages participants to dress up as their favorite superhero or villain! Signage along the race course will feature such famous superheroes as Wonder Woman, Superman and the Flash. The post-race party will feature music, awards and food and beverages.

What do I need at the race?

- Photo I.D.
- Appropriate footwear is highly recommended
- Spending money for parking, drinks, food and merchandise.

When does the event start?

The race will begin at 1:00pm. Gates will open at 11:30am. Please arrive by 12:30pm in order to get checked in and ready to run!

How much does it cost?

- February 1 – May 2: \$25 per adult runner (13 years and up) / **\$12 per youth runner (5-12 years old)
- May 3 – May 8: \$35 per adult runner (13 years and up) / **\$12 per youth runner (5-12 years old)

**Youth participants do not receive race t-shirt

What to leave at home?

- Outside food and beverage
- Pets
- Glass containers
- Weapons and/or firearms

When and where is Packet Pickup?

Beat the Race Day crowds and come by Sozo Friday, May 7 between 5pm and 7pm to pick up your race packet! Race Day packet pickup will also be available starting at 11:30am. Don't forget your photo I.D. and a signed race waiver form to get your packet!

Can I pick up my friends' packet?

Yes, but you will need the following items:

- Copy of your friend's photo I.D.
- Signed letter from the friend stating you are allowed to pick up their packet
- Signed waiver form of the friend participating

What do I get as a race participant?

- Super 5K Race T-shirt (adult participants only)
- Custom Super 5K Medal
- Super 5K Race Bib with free beverage ticket

Where can I leave my gear?

There will be a free gear check area for all of your gear. Your gear check claim ticket is attached to your race bib.

What if there is inclement weather?

Rain or shine, we will race! Super 5K reserves the right to cancel or delay the event if runner, spectator or staff safety is compromised. There will be no refunds.

What about COVID-19 restrictions?

We follow the Health Department's protocols and regulations and encourage participants and spectators to practice social distancing and wash and sanitize your hands often. The Sozo Sports Complex will have multiple hand sanitizing stations set up. Specific restrictions based on the Health Department's guidelines on Race Day will be followed.

How do I volunteer?

We are always looking for individuals or groups that are willing to volunteer for our events. Volunteers will receive bonus swag, discounted race entry and will make some great, fun memories!
